### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Goal is to design and construct a multi-purpose government complex on County owned property that would consolidate 10 County departments to better serve the citizenry and for ease of access and streamlining government services in this Rural Area of Opportunity. New complex allows for the Tenth Judicial System to use existing facilities to meet the demand for more space for Judges Chambers, Clerk of the Courts, public defenders, probation, courtroom and jury selection areas.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

To seek contractual planning, design, engineering and construction services through the County's procurement policies and procedures to consolidate 10 County services into one multi-purpose complex. Current facilities are housed in 60 years plus old buildings that do not meet accessibility and fire safety codes in this Rural Area of Critical Economic Concerns.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services to citizens includes better operations of County services due to consolidation into one complex; provides for easier access and efficient and effective services; reduction of operating costs with savings to the citizenry located in this Rural Area of Critical Economic Concerns/Rural Area of Opportunity.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Hardee County, which is a financially disadvantaged community (ch. 62-552, F.A.C.) that is located in a Rural Area of Economic Concern/Rural Area of Opportunity (s. 288.0656, Florida Statutes), citizenry, visitors, tourists, business community and surrounding areas. Greater than 27,000 expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Completion of the multi-purpose complex for citizens to access 10 government services/depts. in one place and for safe, appropriate facility for personnel to work and serve their community. Reduction of costs to tax payers by consolidation. Current facilities to be utilized by courthouse, state probation, public defenders offices and the Tenth Judicial System. Certification of the project.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Non-payment of invoices until milestones achieved; implementation of corrective action plan.
