These drainage enhancements are designed to elevate flood protection levels and improve water quality within the designated service area. The project's scope includes the installation of new drainage structures and exfiltration trenches. This initiative proves to be a good allocation of taxpayer funds due to its benefits, including safeguarding both public and private properties from flooding, alleviating traffic congestion associated with slow traffic flow during storm events, preventing physical damage to transportation infrastructure, particularly the roadway base, and ultimately reducing the expenditure on roadway repairs.
