In the event of a catastrophic failure to Miami-Dade County's primary EOC (i.e. power failure, cyber-attack, major weather-related damage, etc.), DEM would be required to expeditiously establish its operations at an alternate location with equivalent resources. DEM has designated a secondary location that has never received the resources required to serve as a functional EOC and lacks the technological infrastructure needed to maintain situational awareness and coordinate activities during a major disaster. DEM is respectfully seeking appropriations to bring this location up to the desired status, which will fulfill Miami Dade County's Continuity of Government (COG) and Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP) requirements. These appropriations will make our community safer and will also serve to ensure that DEM will be in compliance with the Emergency Management Accreditation Program's (EMAP) standards.
