Section 1. Section 104.47, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

(1) For the purposes of this section, the term "election worker" means a member of a county canvassing board or an individual who is an election official or poll worker in connection with an election conducted in this state.

(2) A person may not intimidate, threaten, coerce, or harass, or attempt to intimidate, threaten, coerce, or harass, an election worker with the intent to impede or interfere with the performance of the election worker's official duties or with the intent to retaliate against the election worker for the performance of his or her official duties.

(3) A person who violates this section commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
