14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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These funds will be used for design, construction, and construction engineering and inspection of the Biscayne-Everglades Greenway. The funding will be used to complete trail extensions to the west of NE 12 Av. with connections to the existing South Dade Trail / East Coast Greenway along the Busway and downtown Homestead along SW 320 St. (E. Mowry Dr. and W. Mowry Dr.)

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funding will be used to complete trail extensions to the west of NE 12 Av. with connections to the existing South Dade Trail / East Coast Greenway along the Busway and downtown Homestead along SW 320 St. (E. Mowry Dr. and W. Mowry Dr.) in the City of Homestead.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Development of a Greenway Trail to provide recreational and non-motorized transportation services to residents and visitors of Miami-Dade County.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target populations served by this project include elderly persons, persons with poor physical health, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, at-risk youth, physically disabled, grade school students, high school students, university/college students, bicyclists, pedestrians, and other non-motorized transportation users. The project will be easily accessible to the 127,000+ residents in the immediate vicinity of the Biscayne-Everglades Greenway (based on 2020 Census Tract data), as well as the thousands of people who take advantage of the County's other trails that will connect to the Biscayne-Evergaldes Greenway.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will improve physical and mental health (measured by Health Impact Assessment), benefit cultural experiences (measured by attendance/usage), improve environmental quality (measured by Heat Index), protect the general public from harm via pedestrian safety (measured by collision data), improve transportation conditions (measured by Traffic Impact Studies), increase economic activities (measured by RTC report), increase tourism (measured by preand post-build sales tax generated), create specific immediate job opportunities (measured by number of jobs the project generates).

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Payments may be held pending completion of performance measures and deliverables being met.
