The water main will provide an alternative to the wells on the individual properties fronting on the corridor. The forcemain will allow for the properties to have an alternative to septic systems within the impaired basins. Utility extensions within this key corridor prompts development and job creation in and near the airport. Those developments provide alternative revenues that help sustain the airport thereby reducing the cost to air carriers and travelers.
