This project will reconstruct and relocate a pump station from the middle of a busy roadway to the swell on the east side of Inverrary Blvd. that is currently using a portable pump with limited service for the region's communities and businesses.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will improve Wastewater service to residents as well as provide an a a new and improved lift station to pump waste water collected from the residential homes within this basin.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The targeted population is the disadvantaged communities within central portion of the City. approximately 15,000 residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The improvement of the lift station will reduce cost, reduce maintenance repairs, reduce sewer overflows into streets, and to improve operational effectiveness within the Lift station. Method of measurement will be indicated on the reports through the improved efficiency of the new lift station scada system.
