14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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This project will improve water quality in the Banana River between S.R. 528 and Pineda Causeway by reducing nutrients and sediment polluting the river from stormwater contributions. The project will also protect a public park serving the community from flooding, sea level rise, and future storm events. The project is located on S.R. 520 in Cocoa Beach adjacent to Health First Hospital.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The project will will have a three fold benefitial effect 1) environmental, 2) flooding/resiliance, and 3) recreational.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The park will no longer flood. The Banana River will be cleaner. The recreational usage of the park will be exponentially increased and protected from future sea level rise and storms.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project is intended to serve the general public. This would include local residents, Brevard County residents, Florida State residents, and tourists visiting the area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project will will have a three fold benefitial effect 1) environmental, 2) flooding/resiliance, and 3) recreational. The measurement methodology for thr environment aspect will be gallons of stormwater treated prior to discharge into the Banana River, reduction of nitrogen flux reduction from stormwater treatment, and reduction in phosphorous flux from stormwater treatment. The flooding and resiliance will be monitoring. The recreational benefit will be measured in people using the renovated facility.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The city will require performance bonding equal to the cost of construction.

The city has a rigorous veting procedure to select the most responsible contractors to perform the work.

The city also has a legal team to agressively litigate any discrepancies in performnce and deliverables.
