This facility will serve the entire population of Mount Dora, 17,000+, northeast Lake County and Northwest Orange County.

Decreased crime in the area, increased access to broadband internet access, increased health and wellness in the community, increased educational attainment, increased or improved economic activity, create jobs, enhance specific individuals economic self sufficiency, reduce substance abuse, enrich cultural experiences, improve quality of education, and protect the public from harm are all expected outcomes from this project.
