This project will serve the 18,200+ residents of Madison County, in addition to individuals traveling to events from neighboring counties and South Georgia. Madison County is located directly south of the Georgia line, and is centrally located within North Florida. This facility would attract visitors from counties along the Interstate-10 corridor and from southern Georgia.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The construction of this facility will directly increase the number of agriculture-related events within Madison County, which will result in a greater level of public appreciation and understanding of the agriculture industry. This outcome can be empirically observed through the increased number of agriculture-related events. The facility will also host a variety of other events, attracting visitors to the area and resulting in increased tourism revenues.
