The proposed project will include epoxy lining a total of 12,546 lineal feet of existing 8" and 10" gravity sewer trunk line to prevent inflow and infiltration causing overflows at the waste water treatment plant. A total of 39 brick manholes will be lined as part of this project. This collection main is called our South Trunk which transports raw sewage from Mini System E along with all sewage produced within the southern part of the city. This trunk main is in areas of high-water table and is also subject to flooding.

The City of Quincy has continued over the last thirty years to reduce the infiltration within our sewer collection system of fresh storm water by lining sewer lines. The infiltration of storm water into the sanitary sewer lines causes a loss of capacity at our 1.5 MGD at our wastewater treatment facility. Currently, the treatment facility treats .9 MGD. it is not recommended to exceed 75% of the rated capacity of the facility.
