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The appropriation will allow for the construction of a storm sewer system to move storm water runoff from the road surface to a piping system to alleviate the degradation of the roadway.

**c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?**

Improved public safety for 20 economically disadvantaged residences that have excess standing stormwater on the roadway for several days following a large storm event and build a safe public roadway.

**d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?**

Low income economically disadvantaged residents - directly served over 50 residents, but will benefit the entire City system

**e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?**

The proposed storm sewer system will eliminate standing water that sits in the roadway for several days following storm events. This ponded water can pose a threat to public health as it can serve as a breeding ground for mosquitos. Elimination of ponded water in the roadway
