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14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific purpose of this project is to widen an extend an existing two-lane thoroughfare to four-lanes to provide (1) additional east/west road capacity to meet current and anticipated growth in Manatee County, (2) a parallel reliever to the "build-out" State roads (SR64 and SR70), and (3) a continuous route from the gulf coast to East Manatee County.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction of approximately two miles of roadway improvements on 44th Avenue East, from Creekwood Boulevard to Lakewood Ranch Boulevard.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Increase east-west roadway capacity in Manatee County, which will reduce congestion on parallel sections of State Roads 64 and 70 including their respective interchanges at I-75. Additionally, provide a continuous route from the gulf coast to East Manatee County

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General population. The project will serve all individuals who live and travel in and around the project area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Additional capacity for 36,000 vehicles per day in a 4.3-mile corridor and reduction in demand on the parallel state roads by 15,000 to 21,000 vehicles per day, thus reducing congestion and eliminating an anticipated demand for a total two additional lanes on these "built-out" State facilities. Benefit estimated by comparing travel demand model output for build and no-build scenarios. Benefit estimated by comparing travel demand model output for build and no-build scenario using the CUBE-based FSUTMS travel demand model applied to MPO's 2035 LRTP datasets.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The penalties for failing to meet deliverable or performance measures should include withheld disbursement, auditing measures, potential loss of funds, requiring a performance bond, contract retainage, and liquidated damages.
