Tanker fire truck.

The Carr/Clarksville Volunteer Fire Department (CCVFD) is in need of a tanker truck to replace the current truck in its fleet. The current truck has a 1965 trailer with cast iron pipes and requires frequent repairs. Due to its size, many times the truck is unable to be staged close to the emergency event. A new tanker truck will allow the CCVFD to respond to emergency calls, both in Calhoun County and neighboring counties when needed, with a reliable truck able to reach the intended location.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

These funds will allow the Carr/Clarksville VFD to procure a new tanker truck which will be used to respond to emergency calls in Calhoun County as well as surrounding counties, when needed.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The new truck will help the CCVFD to efficiently and effectively respond to any emergency and/or non-emergency situations in the community, for all citizens within the department's range of assistance.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General population of Calhoun County as well as citizens in surrounding counties.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The new fire truck will be available for quick response to fires with the proper equipment, measured by response time and adequate equipment to meet the needs of the calls.

Calhoun County will work with the contracting agency to determine applicable measures should funding be made available.
