#### 4. Project/Program Description

Funding is requested to design and implement a stormwater drainage system on Belvedere Drive on NE 10th Court and 94th Street to prevent ponding/standing water and water intrusion for proper drainage during rainfall events. This flooding occurs approximately 1600 feet from Biscayne Bay. This drainage system would allow the Village to capture water runoff and assure water quality contaminant predictability within the allowances of the NPDES guidelines before it reaches the Biscayne Bay aquifer.

Streets will have less standing water and garages and homes on this street will not be flooded.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Draining water from this residential area will allow residents to have less impact from rain fall as the roadway on NE 94th Street from Bayshore Drive west slopes down into this area creating a great amount of ponding which has in turn resulted in water intrusion in some homes in the area.

The residents will see less water intrusion and damage to their properties with better accessibility and resiliency.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is a residential neighborhood that has direct impact from rainfall events and water intrusion.

The streets will have less standing water so residents can access the roadways to their properties and not have water intrude into their homes, garages and septic systems. The outcome may be measured by inspection of streets during rainfall events. Additionally, the reduction in the amount of complaints received.
