Funding is requested to design and implement a stormwater drainage system on Belvedere Drive on NE 10th Court and 94th Street to prevent ponding/standing water and water intrusion for proper drainage during rainfall events. This flooding occurs approximately 1600 feet from Biscayne Bay. This drainage system would allow the Village to capture water runoff and assure water quality contaminant predictability within the allowances of the NPDES guidelines before it reaches the Biscayne Bay aquifer.
