As recommended by Governor DeSantis, the Florida Legislature allocated \$250 million to the FDOT from the State's American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to help Florida's seaports recover losses caused by the pandemic. Port Canaveral was one of 14 Florida seaports the FDOT deemed eligible to receive funding. Over the last two years, \$65 million has been received in incremental funding as reimbursement for operating expenses only.

14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Current ladder truck was placed in service in 2011 and is approaching the end of its life expectancy for a front-run apparatus which responds to all automatic and mutual aid agreement fire calls. Current truck has limited capabilities with its 75' aluminum ladder. The new truck outfitted with 100' ladder and state of the art equipment will improve fire/emergency response capabilities, reduce environmental impacts, and include new safety features to better serve firefighters and those they serve.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Canaveral Fire Rescue will operate the vehicle. CFR provides fire, emergency medical and hazardous materials response services to Port Canaveral and 26 communities throughout Brevard County, including City of Cape Canaveral, Kennedy Space Center and Patrick Space Force Base. In 2012 the department's only ladder truck responded to 324 calls; 883 calls in 2021; 903 calls in 2022; and will exceed 1,400 calls in 2023.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Maximize firefighter first line response capabilities and minimize injuries risk with apparatus equipped with the latest safety features and operating technology. This ladder truck will enhance the life safety of FL residents, visitors, Port Canaveral employees and users, City of Cape Canaveral, 26 surrounding communities, and businesses by providing improved fire suppression and rescue services.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The general population will be served by the aquisition of the ladder truck, but more specifically some targeted populations that would be directly served would include: structure fire victims, vehicle crash victims, persons with poor physical or mental health, elderly persons, physically disabled, economically disadvantaged persons, victims of crime, drug users, and homeless. The target population to be served is well over 800 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Growth of Port Canaveral operations and its critical infrastructure has increased CFR's emergency call volume. With the arrival of more mega-class cruise ships with some using liquefied natural gas and nearly 20,000 daily visitors; taller cranes in use for cargo, and multiple rocket launches and recoveries nearby, the need for a larger, better equipped ladder truck is paramount. Canaveral Fire Rescue provides reports to detail department's response on monthly and annual basis.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Requesting government (Canaveral Port Authority) would be responsible for reimbursing State of Florida for the amount of the appropriation.
