a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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To accommodate road widening by FDOT and Lee County DOT construction projects. This will also replace aging utilities infrastructure in this area that is at the end of its useful life and minimize cost and impacts to residents by consolidating construction efforts.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Relocation and replacement of approximately 6,500 linear feet of existing water main along Ortiz Avenue from Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (SR82) to Colonial Boulevard (SR884).

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Accommodation of both the widening of Ortiz from Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (SR82) to Colonial Boulevard (SR884) and updating of water main and related utilities service.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General Lee County population.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Replacement of aging infrastructure in this area that is at the end of its useful life. This will be measured by improved distribution system pressure.

Accommodation of the road widening, which is also supported by FDOT. The project will meet required construction milestones.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to adequately fulfill deliverables as contractually agreed can lead to nonpayment and/or contract termination.
