a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of the funds requested is to build tomorrow's leaders, innovators, and problem solvers by providing workforce readiness programs for youth between ages 6 and 18.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Students between the ages of 6 and 18 will be provided opportunities to explore possible career paths and prepare them for future career success with employability skills. Clubs will be able to connect teens to real-life work experiences to help them explore and develop their career interests, such as internships and apprenticeships.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Florida's Boys & Girls Clubs work with school-aged children and youth using approved, evidence-based workforce readiness programs and curricula to encompass a broad range of focus areas, including exploring their interests and passions; developing their employability skills; and applying their knowledge to real-world work experiences.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Florida at-risk youth in grades kindergarten through 12th that attend Florida's Boys & Girls Clubs during out of school time; their families; and the surrounding communities. The program will be provided to 4,000 Florida students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome of this project is to engage youth within their communities, schools, organizations, peer groups, and families in a manner that is productive and constructive; recognizes, utilizes, and enhances young people's strengths; and promotes positive outcomes for young people by providing opportunities, fostering positive relationships, and furnishing the support needed to build on their leadership strengths. The outcome will be measured through the youth's data collected by the local Boys & Girls Clubs, national data, and the analysis from the Clubs' third party evaluator.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?
