14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific purpose to be achieved by funds requested is to deliver innovative service-delivery models for individuals with intellectual, developmental and/or mental disorders, where such individuals will be more immersed in community life via innovative transition services, career paths and employment opportunities, so that the target population can lead fulfilling, productive, contributing, and satisfactory lives. Ultimately, the target population will have more inclusive and experiential career development-services that reverse their historical dismal employment and community inclusion outcomes.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The project will use national evidence-based best practices in delivering innovative approaches to providing career development services and life skills training for the target population. Program evaluations, revamping of programs/services and continued research of best practices will be implemented. Identification of emerging needs and sub-populations will occur to further improve employment and community life outcomes. Development of innovative community partnership opportunities as well as expanded business partnerships for internships (paid/unpaid) will improve quality of life for a historically economically disadvantaged population.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens of this appropriation project will receive the following person-centered direct services: supported access to career-focused education opportunities to increase economic self-sufficiency, self-determination, self-advocacy, work readiness training, job development services, mental health/well-being services, community and independent living education, and experiential learning opportunities.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population are individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities (I/DD) and/or persons with mental health disorders. This includes economically disadvantaged and disenfranchised individuals, unemployed individuals and those with confounding disabilities (physical, mental, etc). The project is expected to serve 100 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit of this project is to create job opportunities which provide at least minimum wage and are consistent with career goals of the participating individuals. This will demonstrate that increased and meaningful community inclusion through work readiness training or functional based life skills training significantly improves the quality of life for the target population. This project will focus on expanding career-focused education, business partnership for on-the-job training and eventual employment to offer greater self-sufficiency.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Corrective action plans and/or financial consequences will be required for non compliance, non performance, unacceptable performance, or failure to meet the minimum level of service or performance under the contract
