This project will provide for the retrofit of Timberlane Creek to enhance the treatment of stormwater prior to entering Lake Jackson, which is a State Aquatic Preserve and an Outstanding Florida Water.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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To reduce phosphorus loads into Timberlane Creek, this project includes a culvert enlargement under Timberlane Road.

This project will protect one of Florida's highly threatened surface water bodies by providing new drainage improvements which will enhance environmental quality through improved stormwater and surface water management.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All residents of and visitors to Leon County will benefit from this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Reduction of the level of phosphorous in stormwater flowing to Lake Jackson. Measured by regular water quality sampling.
