a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Town seeks to mitigate traffic crashes that pose a higher risk to pedestrians and bicyclists. To improve pedestrian safety and walkability in Surfside, the Town has initiated a Town-wide Traffic Study and Downtown Walkability Study. The goal of this project is to integrate traffic flow mitigation strategies that will improve walkability and pedestrian safety in the residential area while also allowing for beautification of the area wherever improvements are made.



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What activities and services will be	provided to meet the intended	purpose of these funds?
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All residents and visitors will benefit from a safer and more walkable residential area throughout the Town of Surfside.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Through this funding the residents and visitors of the area will experience improved pedestrian safety, a more walkable residential area, with beautification components to enhance the outdoor commute experience.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General - The majority of funds will benefit no specific group.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The Town seeks to increase walkability and pedestrian safety throughout its boundaries. The improvements through these Town projects will result in increased walking/biking and outdoor experiences for the community that will make the community more physically active, which will improve overall public physical and mental health. Through increased physical activity the Town expects that the health and built environment connection will reduce stress for the community, thereby resulting in improved mental and physical health as documented through responses received from Town surveys.
