SB 12 Overview

- SB 12 is the result of a two-year effort to address:
 - Barriers identified by law enforcement, courts and families in accessing mental health and substance abuse services.
 - Need for a clearly identified system of acute care services.
 - Improved accessibility to substance abuse services (i.e. Marchman Act)
 - Development of a system of care that is more responsive to Florida's most vulnerable.
 - Intentional coordination of care across community agencies.
