

Gaming

Gaming is an established business sector in Florida; its roots stretch back to the 1890s. Recent rapid changes have transformed gaming industries, but laws and tax policies have not kept pace. Layers of exceptions and patches are not working well to promote the state's overall economic and social welfare.

The situation demands a comprehensive critical assessment, which is the task President Gaetz and Speaker Weatherford set for the Senate and House gaming committees. It will be the Gaming Committees' responsibility to review gambling statutes, to address the ambiguities, inconsistencies, and exceptions in current law, and to craft an action plan.

Florida Gambling Impact Study

The Senate and House jointly commissioned a two-part gaming study to set a factual foundation for important policy choices the Legislature will consider during the 2014 Regular Session. The <u>final report</u> (PDF) is 708 pages (approximately 8.5 MB).



Spectrum Study and Greyhound Decoupling

Key findings from the Spectrum Gaming Group Gambling Impact Study





Decline of Greyhound Racing

- Greyhound racing is "clearly in serious decline." (Final Report PDF page 283)
- Between 1990 and 2012, total greyhound handle in Florida declined by 67%. (Final Report PDF page 135) During the same period, gambling on live dog racing fell by 90%. (Final Report PDF page 135)
- This mirrors a **national trend**. Between 2001 and 2010, total greyhound handle declined by **65%** in all states. (Final Report PDF page 135)
- Florida is one of seven states with greyhound racing, and ten states have outlawed dog racing since 1993. (Final Report PDF page 121)



Impact of State Dog Racing Mandate

- At the same time that dog race betting has sharply dropped, the number of performances has declined by only 6% due to state dog racing mandates. (Final Report PDF page 136)
- "It is clear that pari-mutuel operations at greyhound tracks are **loss leaders** as the tracks sustained a combined operating loss from wagering on greyhounds of \$35 million." (Final Report PDF page 136)
- "Only three tracks made a profit" on dog racing in 2012. (Final Report PDF page 136)
- Dog racing losses were offset by cardroom profits of \$39 million.
 (Final Report PDF page 136)
- "Operators are looking for ways to reduce the costs of operating pari-mutuel events." (Final Report PDF page 137)

How Will Greyhound Decoupling Affect the Industry?

- Greyhound decoupling would result in dog racing ending at **six** tracks. (Final Report PDF page 394) Three of these tracks would "cease live racing within **three years**." (Final Report PDF page 418)
- Three other dog tracks "would stay open but reduce performances" by between 10% and 50%. (Final Report PDF page 418)
- Greyhound decoupling "would not impact revenue sharing per the Seminole contract" and would have "no impact" on cardroom or slot machine revenues. (Final Report PDF page 422)
- Greyhound performances would drop by nearly 40%. (Final Report PDF page
- Ending dog racing at these facilities would "have no impact on the state's gaming industry **under any scenario**." (Final Report PDF page 395)

How Will Greyhound Decoupling Affect the Tracks That Continue Dog Racing?

- Remaining dog tracks "will benefit through higher simulcast revenue." (Final Report PDF page 136)
- Roughly 50% of purses from dog tracks that cease racing would be recaptured. At the tracks that continue greyhound racing, purses would increase by \$2.8 million. (Final Report PDF pages 418, 419 and 420)
- Although dog tracks that continue racing would experience increases in simulcast handle and purses, these increases would likely be temporary. (Final Report PDF pages 419 and 420)



How Will Greyhound Decoupling Affect Taxpayers?

- Total tax revenue from greyhound racing in FY 2012 was \$3.1 million. (Final Report PDF page 421)
- The state spent between \$4.1 million and \$6.4 million regulating greyhound racing. (Final Report PDF page 421)
- State taxpayers lost between **\$1 million** and **\$3.3 million** on dog racing when revenues and costs are taken into account. (Final Report PDF page 421)
- Some of the dog tracks that would stop racing if decoupling passes "generated very little State revenue" and "their closures could be a net gain for the State treasury." (Final Report PDF page 421)
