## **Capital Outlay Revenue Sources**

#### State

- **Public Education Capital Outlay (PECO**) Section 9(a)(2), Article XII, Florida Constitution. Revenue from the gross receipts tax collected on utilities and communication services.
- Capital Outlay & Debt Service (CO&DS) Motor Vehicle License Revenue — Section 9(d), Article XII, Florida Constitution and s. 1010.57, Florida Statutes, (F.S.).


### Local

- Voted Debt Service Millage Section 200.001(3)(e), F.S. and Section 9, Article VII, Florida Constitution. Ad valorem taxes levied for debt service payments on bonds. Authorized by referendum.
- Local Capital Improvement Millage (1.5 mills) Section 1011.71(2), F.S.
   Authorized by school board vote.
- Sales Surtax Sections 212.055(2), Local Government Infrastructure Surtax; and 212.055(6), F.S., School Capital Outlay Surtax. Authorized by referendum.
- Impact Fees Section 163.31801, F.S. Authorized by local governments.




### **Historical Fixed Capital Outlay Funding**

(State and Local Sources) 2008-09 through 2015-16






## Historical Fixed Capital Outlay Funding – State Sources 2008-09 through 2015-16





## Historical Fixed Capital Outlay Funding – Local Sources 2008-09 through 2015-16







2008-09 through 2015-16







### **Charter School Growth: 1995-2017**



## **Charter School Capital Outlay**

Section 1013.62, Florida Statutes

- Annual appropriation
- Eligibility criteria (s. 1013.62, F.S.)
  - 2 full years of operation complete
    - Several exceptions to the 2-year requirement, including SACS accreditation
  - Financial and academic standing
  - Approved by District to operate
  - Cannot operate in District owned facility
- 535 of 654 charter schools have received capital outlay in 2016-17
  - 82%
- Allocated to schools on per FTE basis



## **Charter School Capital Outlay**

Section 1013.62, Florida Statutes

- Weighted funding for schools that serve certain populations
  - > 75% Free or reduced lunch (criteria 1)
  - > 25% Students with disabilities (criteria 2)
- Schools that do not meet either criteria
  - 353 of 535 (66%)
- Schools that meet criteria 1
  - FTE multiplied by a weight of 1.25
  - 136 of 535 (25%)
- Schools that meet criteria 2
  - FTE multiplied by a weight of 1.25
  - 31 of 535 schools (6%)
- Schools that meet criteria 1 and 2
  - FTE multiplied by a weight of 1.5
  - 15 of 535 (3%)



Purchase, lease-purchase, or lease of driver's education vehicles; motor vehicles used for the maintenance or operation of plants and equipment; security vehicles; or vehicles used in storing or distributing materials and equipment	88%
