Summer Learning Academies provide student and parental enrichment that has been recognized in Florida and nationally through the Aspen Institute, the Patterson Foundation, the Florida Chamber of Commerce Foundation, and locally by the Community Foundation of Sarasota County. These academies prevent summer regression for children by bolstering academic achievement to ensure profiencies in language arts and math. Parents of the children, who are mostly considered "at-risk," are also involved in the project, and receive training to improve literacy, enhance job skills, and like services. The School Board of Sarasota County estimates it will serve about 800 people should these funds be awarded.

<u>At-risk students enrolled in Title I schools (approx. 90% on free and reduced lunch and 50% from single parent</u> households). The School Board of Sarasota County estimates it will serve about 800 people should these funds be awarded.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

<u>Enhanced student performance and better outcomes based on parental enrichment and involvment.</u> <u>Outcomes will measure student enhanced performance using iReady reading assessments comparing students</u> <u>who attended the Summer Learning Academy with students who did not attend from same school; surveys and</u> <u>comments from students and parents; and attendance records of students who attended the Summer Learning</u> <u>Academy compared to students that did not from the same school. Outcomes will measure parent participation</u> <u>in the Parent University; parents enrolling in Adult Education Courses following completion or while enrolled in</u> <u>the Parent University.</u>
