a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

<u>Margate's storm water pipe infrastructure is at or beyond it's useful lifespan. Continuous issues include</u> <u>collapses, sinkholes, and depressions in roadways caused by perforations in the pipes and interruptions in the</u> <u>drainage of roadways due to pipe blockages related to failures of the pipe metal. By lining or replacing pipes,</u> <u>the City will be improving the stormwater infrastructure for the next 50 years, resulting in a decreased flooding</u> <u>risk, sinkholes, road depressions, and drainage blocks.</u>

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

<u>Funding will be used to either line or replace storm water pipe that is 50-65 years of age. It is estimated that</u> the City will be able to line or replace approximately 4,000 linear feet of stormwater pipes as part of this project.
