<u>Funds will be used to develop a business case study, begin addressing known infrastructure needs and develop projections to create a national test center for certification of numerous technologies related to Connected and Autonomous Vehicles (CAV). This work will be done in conjunction with the Florida Turnpike Enterprise SunTrax and be used to attract the CAV industry to Florida.</u>

#### b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

<u>Experts and Florida Polytechnic staff will complete a third party study to more narrowly define how Florida can</u> become more competitive in the CAV market, which is predicted to be an \$87 billion industry.

Short-term benefits of the project are to clearly define Florida's role in the CAV market and position our state to fully participate in a predicted \$87 billion industry. This outcome will be measured by the study. Long-term benefits include fewer vehicle accidents on Florida roads as measured by accident count; increased traffic capacity of some Florida roads as measured by annual vehicle counts; and increase in jobs in the CAV industry as measured by federal and DEO occupational data.
