These lines will allow for full compliance with the Wekiva Act restrictions on septic systems.

The purpose of the Wolf Branch Innovation District is to enhance educational, medical and economic activity in the area. The City of Mount Dora is actively seeking Lake Sumter State College to develop a branch campus and several medical uses as anchors to the district. It is anticipated that numerous other potential businesses and employment opportunities will follow. The City will be able to measure number of new jobs and per capital income impacts from the District. Additionally, the City will be able to measure number of students attending LSSC and patients served by medical facilities.
