d. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

<u>The Bluffs is a 6,400 acre industrial cluster on the lower Escambia River in Escambia County, FL. Over the past</u> several years, DEO/FDOT have been investing in the development of competitive sites for advanced manufacturing and economic diversification. This initiative is part of the goals and objectives outlined in the "Florida Trade and Logistics Study 2.0." The citizens stand to benefit from the development of this site inventory through the associated jobs, economic diversification and economic growth.

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

<u>The Bluffs industrial development will impact working-age adults and their families in the Florida Panhandle.</u> <u>Economic studies have predicted an impact of about 15,000 direct jobs at full development.</u>

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

<u>As a large-scale industrial cluster, The Bluffs has been evaluated for economic return and/or impact by a</u> <u>number of experts and interest groups. The 25-year program is expected to generate approximately 15,000</u> <u>direct jobs and a payroll of \$550 million. As the competitive advanced manufacturing sites are developed and</u> <u>marketed, progress toward the programmatic goal will be reported to the various project stakeholders and</u> <u>responsible agencies at annual intervals.</u>
