a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

In partnership with the City of Naples, this project seeks State funds to replace and upgrade the 40+year old water delivery system within the Bayshore Gateway Triangle Area. The current water delivery system is undersized, comprised of outdated and inferior materials, and not capable of supporting fire flows. There are too few fire hydrants and inadequate spacing and dead-end pipe segments with no looping.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Asbestos cement, cast iron and ductile pipes will be removed and upgraded. Fire hydrants will be added to assist the Fire District in protecting the residents of the Bayshore area.

The goal of the project is to reduce the potential for loss of life and property through improved fire suppression (fire hydrants), and improve public health and safety through water quality improvements.

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Currently, 21% of the Bayshore Gateway Area are at or below the poverty level. 33% of the Area residents are minorities. Approximately 240 residents would be served by this project.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The completed project will increase public safety, improve water pressure and water quality. Performance measures could include monitoring water quality tests and responses to fires.
