a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

1.These funds will be used to create an educational guest experience at The Florida Aquarium's downtown Tampa campus that engages guests on the conservation efforts occurring at the Center for Conservation, highlighting the critical work being led by The Florida Aquarium and Florida Fish & Wildlife Commission (FWC) that encourages their engagement at the Center for Conservation location in Apollo Beach. 2. Fully outfit Coral Ark One at the Center for Conservation with life support systems for the most effective regrowth and research on endangered corals.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The new and enhanced educational guest experience will occur in The Florida Aquarium's second largest habitat at the downtown Tampa location. This includes constructing a back of house aquatic support system to quarantine incoming animals and serve as an animal holding area should a medical emergency arise. The collection of marine animals will consist of endangered and non-endangered species, including eagle rays and sea turtles. Guests will see, hear and interact with our team about the critical work being done at the Center for Conservation by The Florida Aquarium and Florida Fish & Wildlife Commission (FWC). Additionally, these funds will be used to outfit Coral Ark One in Apollo Beach. It will include smaller closed system tanks and pools to better monitor the corals. The ark will utilize higher filtration methods for the purest and most controlled water for regrowth and maintenance of rescued corals. Research equipment for each of these processes will also be acquired.
