11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

Building to house four academic programs to meet workforce needs in high skill/high wage jobs. Programs will serve 250 new students per year. The building will house classrooms and laboratories for four programs not currently offered on the west side of Volusia County: a full Nursing (RN) program, Diagnostic Sonography, Radiography and Machining. Job growth in these areas ranges from 12-30% in the next five years, with hourly wages between \$19-30/hour. All four occupations are targeted industries for Volusia and Flagler counties.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

<u>The building will house classrooms and labs for four academic programs (a full Nursing (RN) program,</u> <u>Diagnostic Sonography, Radiography and Machining)</u>. Activities to take place in the building include lecture classes, hands-on laboratory classes, tutoring and other academic support services.

d. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Instruction in the fields of Nursing, Radiography, Diagnostic Sonography and Machining. Graduates of these programs (all 2 years or less) will be able to enter jobs immediately. Job growth in these areas ranges from 12-30% in the next five years, with hourly wages between \$19-30/hour. All four occupations are targeted industries for Volusia and Flagler counties.

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

<u>Anyone in our region who wishes to enter the programs</u>. Daytona State College is an open-door institution. Expected enrollment is 250 students per year in the four programs, with growth expected annually.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit will be local residents graduating with associates degrees in Nursing, Radiography and Diagnostic Sonography, and vocational certificates in Machining. All lead to high wage jobs that are Enterprise Florida Inc Targeted Industries in Volusia and Flagler counties. The currently used portable classrooms are highly susceptible to hurricane damage and need to be replaced. Graduation rates, job placement rates and annual wages are all reported to the state annually and are used in computing performance measures for each Florida State College.
