These additional student stations will serve 552 full-time equivalent (FTE) students.

This renovation will add 105 student stations & related spaces & provide needed educational upgrades for programs. Additional student stations will serve 620 full-time equivalent (FTE) students.

Established in 1004.74 F.S., the Florida School of the Arts at St. Johns River State College is charged with offering "a program of academic and artistic studies in the visual and performing arts" and "shall serve as a professional school on a statewide basis for all qualified students". Florida School of the Arts trains performing and visual artists and provides cultural experiences in visual and performing arts to the community.
