Each year, thousands of students with disabilities "age out" of Florida schools and lose their only "lifeline" to the outside world. Our unique instruction model is created using adult individualized education plans and activities based on the interests, needs, and abilities of this population.

Funding will be used to continue to provide the critically needed community-based services and to expand our "Dre's Café" Enterprise which will all Participants to secure meaningful employment, and enjoy fulfilling lives as active and contributing members of their families and community. It is anticipated that this funding will result in annual increase in program participants as well as, the communities we serve.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

_Dre's Pathway to Possibilities provides a full day of skill-developing activities and activities of recreation and leisure that exceeds the intended purpose of the requested funds; instruction on human rights, basic Spanish, daily living skills, banking and finance, proper diet and exercise, personal hygiene and self -care, housekeeping, art and music therapy, weekly "mixers", community-based instruction, sexuality and socialization opportunities. In addition, supported living, supported employment, community resources and other services and supports are available to every student.
