Storm water surges into local businesses and residential areas will be significantly reduced and controlled during rainy season, and during severe weather occurrences such as tropical storms and hurricanes. The proposed plans to renovate other amenities and mix-use space for which future exploration for business development will be possible if acceptable storm water prevention measures could be restored to modern codes and operation.
