Existing Companies and their employees will be provided an alternative route to and from the Industrial parks.

A connection road will provide greater accessibility for the 27 companies that employ 2,500 + workers.

The infrastructure improvements will benefit multiple future businesses as it will increase the marketability of the publicly owned industrial zoned property located in Santa Rosa Park East. Through this assistance, an additional 120 industrial zoned acres will be made available to small and medium size businesses that are looking to relocate to Santa Rosa County and Florida.

Liquidated damages vary in amount based on construction costs and time (An estimated average - \$750 per day).
