The Motivational Edge's Campus is a safe, supportive environment designed to celebrate students' achievements and unleash their imaginations! This state-of-the-art, multipurpose creative space allows students to delve into our Arts, Technology and Sports & Wellness programming, while holding academics in high regard, with all students earning a "C" or below in a core subject required to participate in no-cost tutoring. The Campus features a vast indoor space with an Ideation Lab for 3-D printing, photography, video production, graphic design and more, a recording studio, a multi-purpose space perfect for hosting student exhibitions, a studio for dance, yoga, martial arts and so much more! Outside, there is a turf field with bleachers, batting cages and a large BBQ for community events. This Campus is one-of-a-kind in Miami-Dade County, empowering local youth to engage in positive self-expression, develop essential life skills and become thriving future leaders in our community.

11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific purpose of The Motivational Edge's Miami Campus is to offer an organized, stress-free, stimulating environment with cutting edge and engaging programs to educate and empower young people to take responsibility for their actions, propelling them toward success in school and in life. In doing so, our students improve academically, demonstrate emotional maturity and growth of character, and exhibit enhanced employability skills.



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b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Motivational Edge's Miami Campus is a diverse cultural environment, offering wrap-around youth development services 7 days per week, encompassing academics, various forms of therapeutic arts paired with a mental health therapist, and sports and wellness, including: The Art of Creative Writing & Lyrical Expression, Audio Recording, Urban Arts Expression and Dance Expression. The students in our programs increase academic achievement, gain essential life skills and strengthen their emotional well-being. A mental health therapist will be readily available to ensure that the needs of our high intensive students are being met. Our work readiness programs are designed to provide opportunities to gain knowledge in entrepreneurship and increase employment placements for our young adults. The Motivational Edge will achieve its mission of helping young people successfully transition into adulthood by partnering with other non-profits and public and private entities across Florida.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

The following services and programs will be offered to each participant: Academic assistance, counseling, music programs, visual arts programs, dance and performing arts, sports and wellness, coding, web design, photo/video, job training and other support services aimed at strengthening students and or families.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The populations served will be at-risk and/or economically disadvantaged 5-18 years old, with some services being offered to transitioning young adults exiting the Child Welfare System. Students will come from the local Allapattah Community and surrounding areas, and may also be referred through our many partnerships with the Child Welfare System, homeless agencies and others. We anticipate 250 young people will be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected outcomes and benefits include: Increased academic achievement, improved mental health, increased emotional intelligence, growth of character and self-worth, increased motivation in and out of school, ability to identify high-risk behaviors that are social deterrents of health and enriched cultural experiences. The methodology is unique to our agency and developed from a multitude of best practices; all captured in our customized Salesforce system. Due to our unique application process and compassionate, non-threatening approach, we are able to capture vital information from the child and parent/guardian to help shape the programming moving forward, ensuring that shared goals are met. A baseline assessment is administered and ongoing assessments gauge the level of growth/improvement in a variety of key areas derived from the Casey Life Skills set. The Motivational Edge focuses on self-care, social relationships and communication that directly impacts behavioral health.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Withholding of payments is fully understandable if we fail to meet the performance measures. The Motivational Edge will internally audit and reflect on all aspects of the program in an effort to maintain fidelity and remedy any discrepancies.
