It will deliver data-driven, just-in-time support through sequenced actions focused on specific needs, expert-curated resources, and access to a network of peers. The Principal's Playbook will combine this with coaching, mentoring, and collaboration experiences—all in one centralized place. Each principal will be provided a coach through the Florida Association of School Administrators (FASA).

 - Improve persistently low-performing schools by providing direct support to school and district leadership though data-driven improvement plays and virtual coaching.
- b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
 Each school and district leader and their coach will be provided access to the Principal's Playbook platform for the 2019-20 school year.
- c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?
 - District and school leaders participating in the Principal's Playbook project will be provided with research-based and evidenced-based actions and coaching support targeted at improving student performance in their schools and districts.
- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
 - The target population are school and district leaders serving persistently low-performing K-12 schools. 250 leaders and 50 leadership coaches are expected to participate.

 - The benefit of this pilot will be improved student achievement and performance in persistently low-performing schools and a model that can be replicated with other low performing schools. Outcomes will be measured through the Florida Standards Assessment.
