For the Children Inc. is a not-for-profit agency located at the historic Osborne School since April 2000 to present. In 2008 For The Children Inc. placed the land on the referedum asking voters in the City of Lake Worth to donate the land to For The Children for 100 years at \$12.00 per year. The whole parcel is about 4.6 acres of land with a three room schoolhouse which now serves 50 low income families with quality and effective education, recreational, and family support services. For The Children has \$1 million in reserve for a building expansion and is seeking an additional \$1.5 million to complete the first two phases by April 2020.

The goal of the Community Learning Center is to expand our current facility to serve more families and children ages 3-22 to include early childhood, after school programming for youth ages 6-12, youth and family support services to include programming for high school seniors and juniors who are at risk of not meeting graduation requirements with SAT and ACT test prep along with support to apply for FASFA, college applications, and tour state universities. Algebra tutoring for ninth graders will also be provided as they will need to pass to graduate.

#### b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Upon completion of phase 1 and phase 2 of the building expansion, the Community Learning Center will be the hub for those residing in the service area to access a variety of activities to include SAT and ACT for seniors and juniors and family support services will be offered in the evening and on weekends including English language classes, health and nutrition classes, and mental fitness classes.

#### c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Serve families and children ages 3-22 to include early childhood, after school programming for youth ages 6-12, youth and family support services to include programming for high school seniors and juniors who are at risk of not meeting graduation requirements with SAT and ACT test prep along with support to apply for FASFA, college applications, and tour state universities. Algebra tutoring for ninth graders will also be provided as they will need to pass to graduate. On weekends English language classes, health and nutrition classes, and mental fitness classes will be held for the community.

The Community Learning Center will serve over 200 families and children who are English language learners residing in Lake Worth, Lantana, Greenacres and Boynton Beach.
