4. Project/Program Description:

The Florida Keys Overseas Heritage Trail (FKOHT) is a multi-use bicycle and pedestrian facility that also serves as a recreation and alternative transportation corridor for the Florida Keys. The trail features more than 70 miles of existing trail paved in segments along a planned, 106-mile corridor from Key Largo to Key West. Much of the trail has been completed, except for the section between mile markers 16-20, the "Sugarloaf section." This is the largest, unfinished segment of the trail. It has experienced long delays due to shoreline erosion, design issues, and lack of funding. Because it is a large segment, the County has supported phasing its construction. In 2018, the State funded the design and permitting, which is underway and will be completed in the Spring of 2019. The project is being designed so that the construction can be completed in three discrete phases; each phase will cost approximately \$3m. We are requesting \$3m in funding to construct the first phase.

11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

We are requesting funding to complete one of the last, unfinished segment of the Florida Keys Overseas Heritage Trail. This trail is an important recreational and alternative transportation corridor that connects the Key Largo to Key West. While much of the trail in the upper Keys has been completed, the segment in the lower Keys between MM 16-20 has experienced years of delays. The FKOHT provides a showcase of the state's and the Keys' environmental resources and attracts hundreds of thousands of users annually. These outstanding merits of the trail cannot be fully realized until it's complete from end to end. The incomplete segment also poses safety hazards to trail users. The design and permitting was funded last year and will be completed this spring. The project has been designed so that construction can occur in three different phases. This is a request for funding for the construction of the first phase.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

FKOHT is a multi-use bicycle and pedestrian facility that serves as a recreational and alternative transportation corridor for the Florida Keys. Paralleling U.S. Highway 1, which is designated as a National Scenic Highway and All-American Road, this recreational pathway incorporates 23 of the historic Flagler Railroad bridges, offering a scenic venue for hiking, running, bicycling, skating, sightseeing, fishing, and paddling. The trail and its historic bridges provide a beneficial, alternative transportation route that links the Keys' island communities. It is also a valuable tourist attraction. The unfinished section is dangerous to the trail's many users, and must be completed to ensure safety for residents and tourists.

The trail and its historic bridges provide an important recreational venue, a valuable tourist attraction, and a beneficial, alternative transportation route that links the Keys' island communities. The trail serves as a showcase for statewide environmental and ecological attractions throughout the Keys, including the Everglades National Park, Biscayne National Park, Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary, and the Great White Heron National Wildlife Refuge.
