As part of our conservation mission, ZooTampa provides a haven and medical care for Florida panthers deemed non-releasable by FWC. Because their numbers are growing, human/panther conflicts are becoming more frequent and there is a critical need for medical facilities to treat and release panthers. The funds will also allow for construction of 6 habitats for up to 6 panthers non releasable panthers. Currently, three non-releasable panthers reside at ZooTampa with outdoor habitats for only one panther. The three rotate days.
