These funds will be used to continue the lighthouse restoration activities by reconstructing a historically significant Lighthouse Keepers' Cottage and operating it as an Education Center. The Education Center will be staffed by experienced volunteers who will focus on a broad range of topics (Lighthouse Keepers, Fresnel lens, Native Americans, the citrus industry, the maritime history, and the space program). Reconstructing the lighthouse facilities will benefit Florida's historic preservation, certain Indian tribes, and the state by providing an on-going, long-term educational, and preservation activities.

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Education Center will have interactive programs which students throughout the state can utilize to experience the unique and trailblazing history of the site. Information will chronicle the space program and the history of the state's Native Americans.

The reconstruction will restore the historical configuration of the building that existed during the period 1868-1950. The facility will be used as an Education Center where lectures and interactive programs will be presented to visitors.

The Lighthouse Keepers' Cottages are unique tourist and education attractions for the community, the state of Florida and the nation.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Local residents, students, and tourists, many of whom come to Brevard County via cruise ships (Port Canaveral is the second largest cruise port in the United States). The number of individuals expected to visit the Education Center are 5,000+ annually.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit of this project will be an opportunity to experience the background of the Native Americans who resided in the area and the challenge for the Lighthouse Keepers' families living and working at the lighthouse under arduous conditions. The early settlers and pioneers at the Cape is a unique tale that is an essential part of the chronicle of the lighthouse. Future generations will be exposed to the diverse and delicate ecosystem.



The methodology that will be used to measure the outcome will be increased number of visitors to the Cape Canaveral Lighthouse.
