#### 4. Project/Program Description:

The Town of Cutler Bay is requesting \$175,000 to assist with the development and implementation of the Town Center District Small Business Incubator. This project is located in a newly designated Opportunity Zone. The primary goal of the Business Incubator is to attract new high-tech, research and development (R&D) and manufacturing start-up companies to the Town of Cutler Bay. The town is currently in the design phase; the business incubator will provide promising startups in the fields of technology, research and development with below market rent and technical assistance in the form of educational business workshops. The Town will also target small business owners from low to moderate income (LMI) households living in the South Dade Community and service businesses with an annual income of less than \$300,000. These individuals will have access to workshops, temporary meeting space, and office space at free or reduced rates.

#### a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

Outcome 1: Stimulate economic development by implement a strategy to attract new high-tech, R&D, and manufacturing start-up companies to the Town of Cutler Bay. Performance Measure: Conduct building use study to identify space and development needs within the Town Center Building to house the incubator. Buildout of business incubator. Outcome 2: Facilitate use or reuse of existing infrastructure by providing technical assistance/training to town staff, members of the Economic Development Council, and the business community to allow them to fully participate in this project. Performance Measure: Host a series public involvement meetings to increase awareness about the business incubator, and receive public input. Develop a marketing strategy to recruit new businesses.

### b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

This project provides affordable or free office/meeting space to start-up companies in the south Miami-Dade community. The project is located within an Opportunity Zone in the Cutler Bay Town Center District.

### c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Direct services include scheduling workshops through partnership with the US Small Business Administration and other economic development community agencies. Topics may include: time management, marketing strategies, HR, Ethics, and money management.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The proposed project will provide space for up to 25 small businesses. Scheduled workshops will be open to the general public and may attract 100 businesses from the local community throughout the year.
