A new wastewater treatment plant will eventually be needed in connection with the Ocean Outfall compliance plan as capacity is limited at some existing plants and additional capacity needs are anticipated for the future. This project is to acquire land now for a new wastewater plant to be constructed in the future. The land in question, in the western part of the County, is expected to cost up to \$17 million, of which \$2 million is being requested. Several parcels have already been acquired from willing sellers.
