11. Program Performance:

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

Increased near-dock cargo handling area. Port Manatee's cargo handling operations are currently constrained by storm water treatment ponds in near-dock areas. One pond is 5.75 acres in size and the other is .43 acres in size. Section 311.106 (2017) provides Florida seaports the opportunity to provide offsite storm water treatment mitigation in lieu of storm water treatment ponds in these high-value, near-dock areas on the premise that the same net level of protection is provided. If suitable offsite storm water treatment is available, the value of the property if the ponds were filled is \$33,650 per month (at tariff rate of \$0.125 per square foot). This figure does not include the additional wharfage revenues that could be generated by the additional land. This project has the potential to provide additional seaport development and create additional jobs, while providing the same protection to the environment.



b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

A study of the opportunities to meet the requirements of the legislation for implementation to realize the benefits of the legislation - more near-dock cargo handling area.

c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Identification of opportunities, the first step toward improving Port Manatee's efficiency by increasing neardock cargo handling areas.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The citizens of Florida in general, especially the region served by Port Manatee and the citizens of Manatee County.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increase in near-dock cargo handling areas at Port Manatee, measured in terms of acres.
