1. Title of Project: Tallahassee Community College Nursing Program

#### 4. Project/Program Description:

Expansion of our successful Bachelors of Science in Nursing (BSN) and Associate of Science in Nursing/Registered Nurse degree programs due to the need in our service area for additional nurses. The ADN program produces approximately 70 students each year. The BSN program is designed for RNs who have completed an Associate in Science degree in nursing (ADN) and to meet the needs of students who are employed as nurses. The program currently enrolls approximately 60 new students annually. Tallahassee Memorial Hospital (TMH), a major employer of nurses in the region, advertises nationally to fill its 250 annual vacancies, but is able to hire only 58% of its nurses with baccalaureate degree. The FL Department of Economic Opportunity (FDEO) data projects 114 annual job openings in TCC's district. Although both FSU and FAMU have a BSN program, fewer than 25% of those graduates remain in the district.

a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

TCC will expand our successful Bachelors of Science in Nursing (BSN) and Associate of Science in Nursing/Registered Nurse degree programs due to the need in our service area for additional nurses with advanced educational preparation. We will increase instructional staffing and remodel 21,075 square feet to includes classrooms, simulation center, and necessary mechanical upgrades.

The purpose of the funds is to provide high-tech equipment and facilities, as well as the best qualified instructors to provide an expansion of the BSN nursing program at Tallahassee Community College. The program is 120 credit hours with an anticipated enrollment of 240 students per year.
