a. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds requested?

To show that digital license plates are less confusing and make it easier to track vehicles and employees. The long term goal is to save taxpayer funds through time management.

- b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?
 Training for agency staff on how to install, use, and track digital plates
- c. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?
 - Better time management by both agency administrative staff and staff in the field using those vehicles with the digital plates. Eventual cost saving to tax payers.
- d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served? State owned vehicles and state employees. Up to 1000 vehicles, depending on the department's vehicle selection.
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
 - Better tracking of state vehicles and state employees. Each plate has GPS tracking function as well as two specific groupings of numbers on the plate. One number is assigned to the driver and another number is assigned to the agency/vehicle type/vehicle purposes.
