- 1. Title of Project: Public Safety Training Facility

- 4. Project/Program Description:

Seven acre training site dedicated to the critical training components associated with both Police and Fire public safety responsibilities. Included within this project will be an indoor firearms range. Because officers are faced with split second life or death situations in their daily duties, it is critical they develop the confidence and conditioned responses necessary to ensure the safest resolutions possible. This facility will better position our agency to provide superior firearms and scenario-based training as the most prudent means to enhance our ability to save the lives of our officers and the community we serve. This new 24,000 sq. ft. indoor firearms training facility will provide the learning environment necessary for the Kissimmee Law Enforcement Officers to meet the challenges they face each day. The project is projected to cost \$8.66M with a shortfall of \$965,000 for the firearms targeting system for the firing range.

The Kissimmee Police Department serves a community of over 70,000 residents and 1.2M visitors. Our international appeal and location encourages partnerships and training with regional and Federal law enforcement agencies who will also have the ability to utilize the training facility. These agencies include: Osceola County Sheriff's Office, St. Cloud Police, Federal Air Marshall, and the Law Enforcement Academy at Osceola Technical College.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

To provide state of the art firearms and scenario-based training to our local law enforcement professionals. Improve and enhance weapons and response proficiency of our personnel. Compare proficiency standards against previous years based on continual scoring of training evolutions.
