The proposed project is to construct a combined city complex that can house all the town's service departments including city hall, the fire department, and public works. The existing buildings are aged and undersized for the Town's workforce. To better serve the community, the town complex is proposed to be constructed on town-owned property near the intersection of State Road 90 and State Road 69 in Grand Ridge.

This building will house the fire department, public works, and town hall (administration) which provides sewer, water, and garbage services to the citizens of Grand Ridge. This will provide citizens with a centralized building from which they can have access to all of the town's services.

This will improve the service provided by the fire department, public works, and town hall (administration, sewer, water, and garbage) to the constituents.
